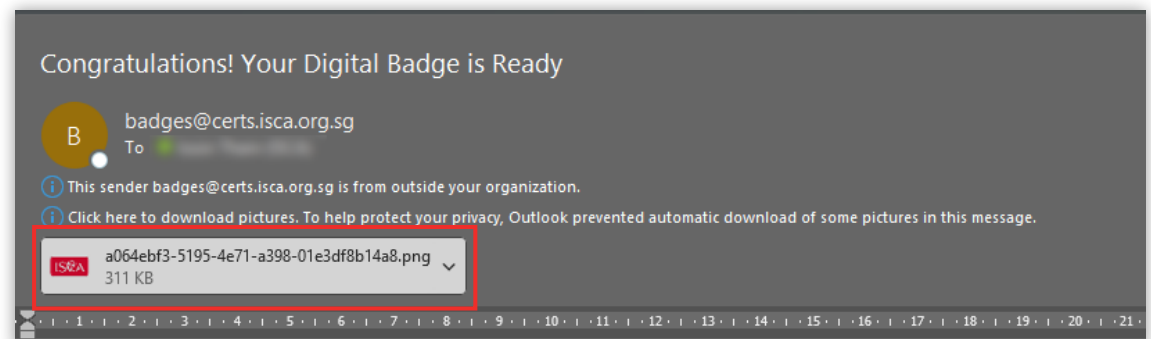
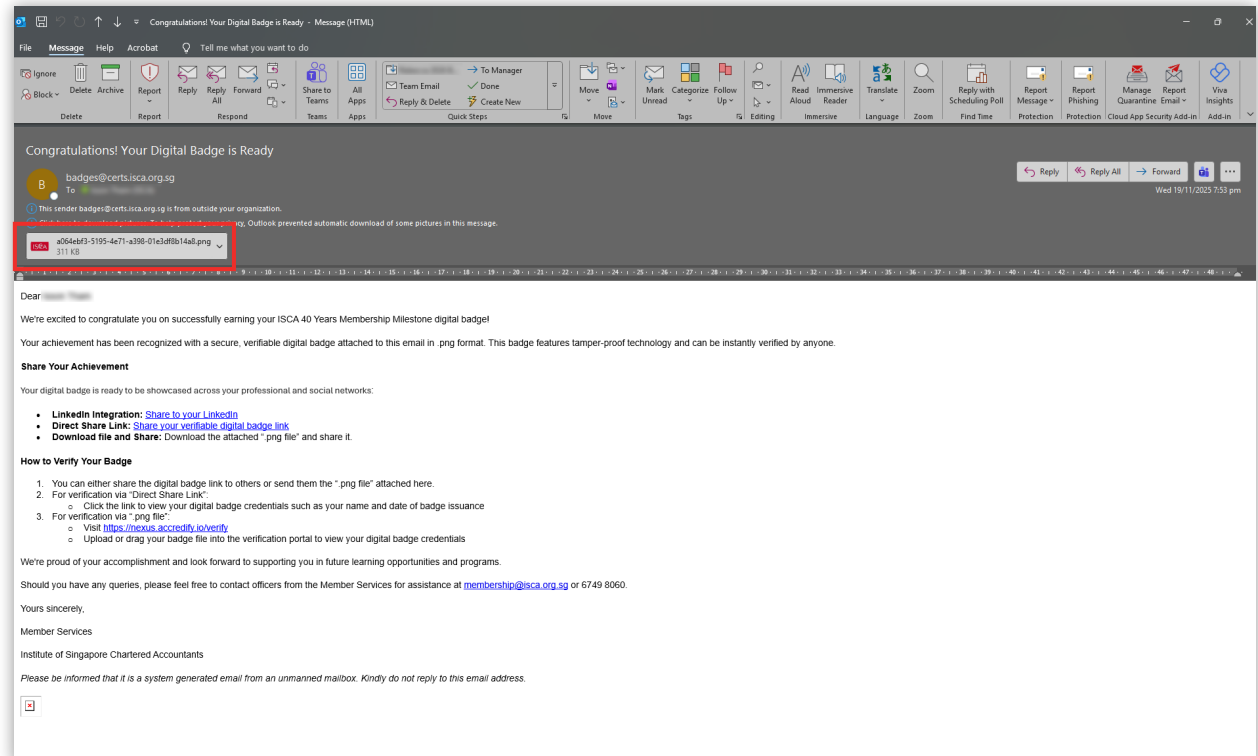
Digital badges allow people to verify your skills and achievements through information attached to the badge.

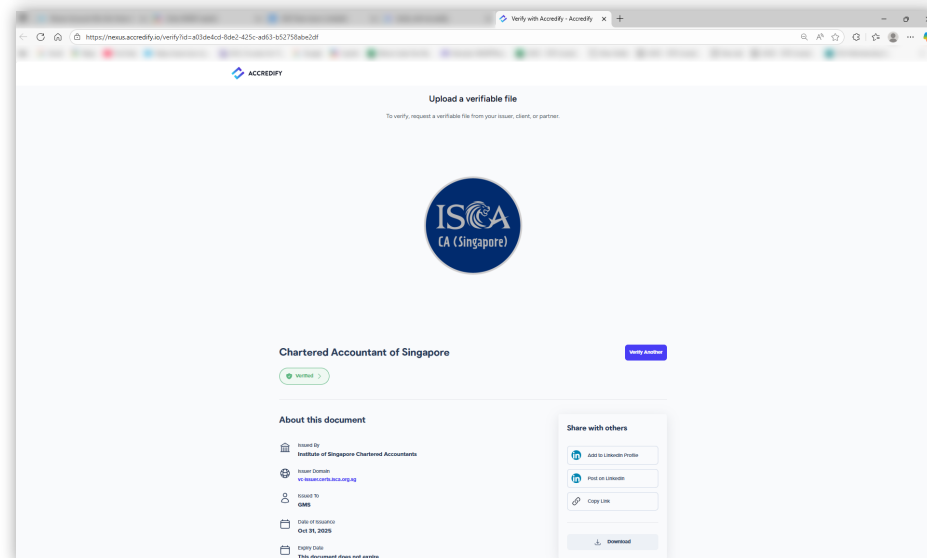
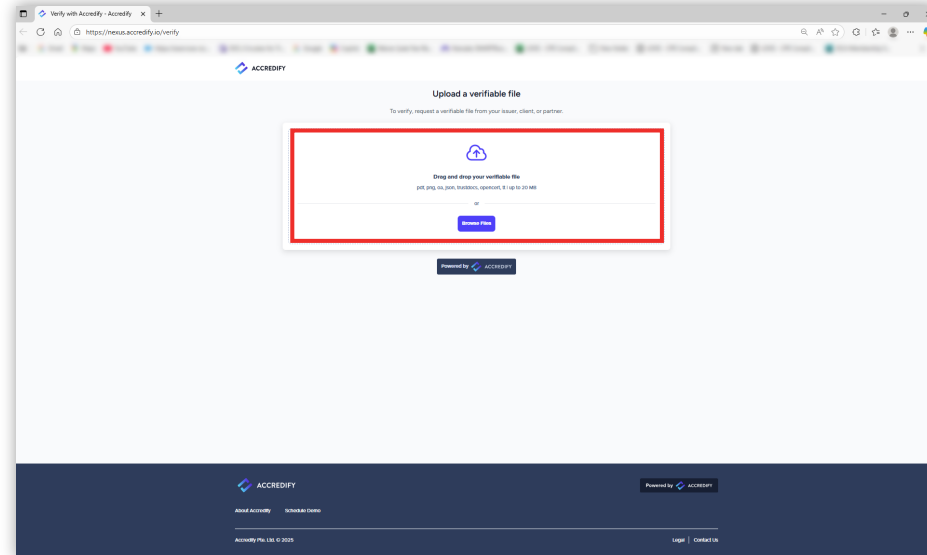

- Upload or drag your badge file into the verification portal.



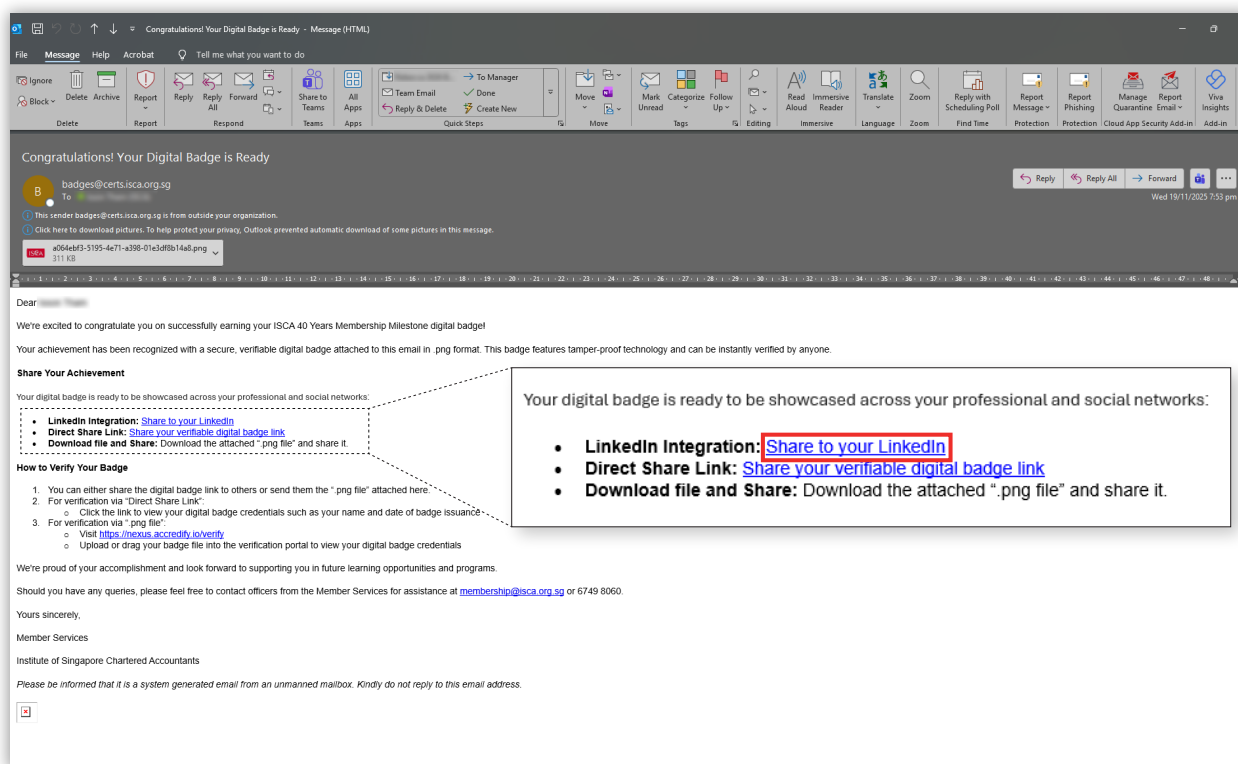
HOW TO SHARE YOUR DIGITAL BADGE ON LINKEDIN

- Review the pre-populated information and click "Save" to complete the process.



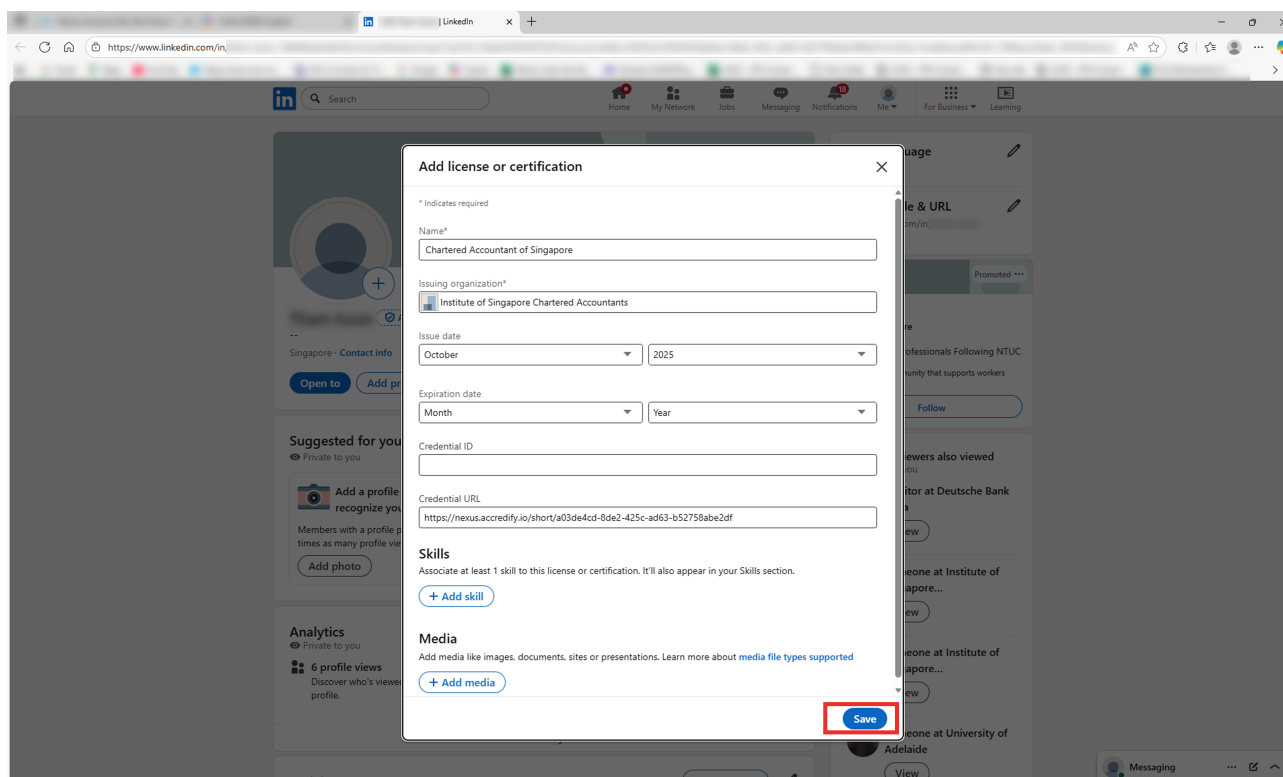
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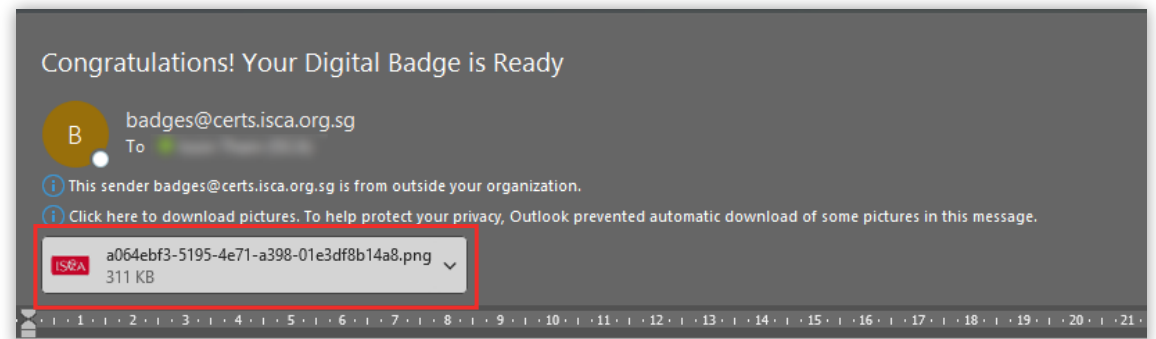
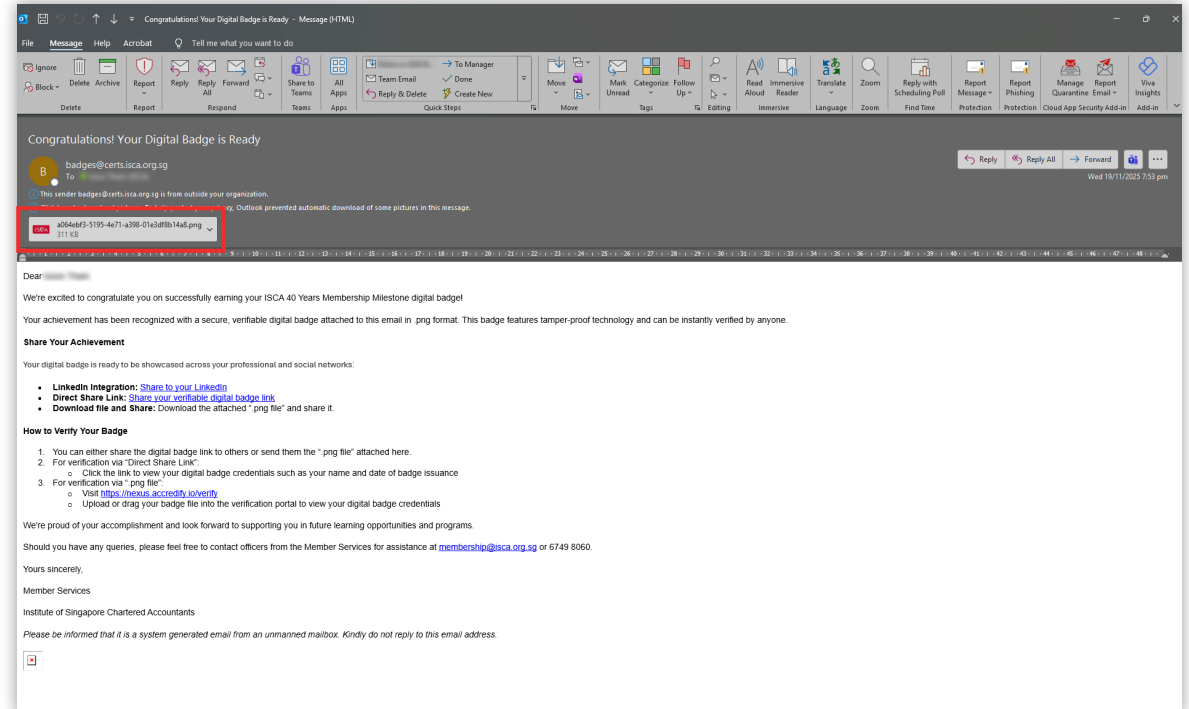
